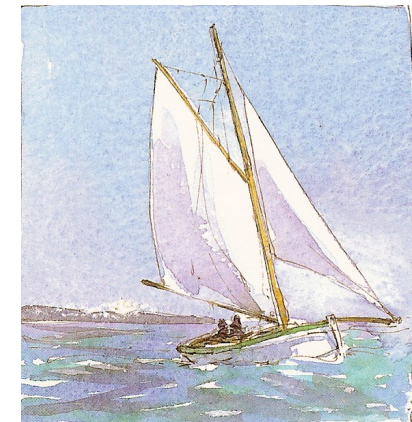

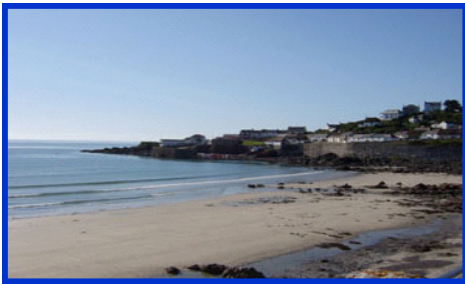

## The Location

Coverack is situated on the South West coast of Cornwall on the Lizard Peninsula. It is a small traditional fishing village and is a spectacular location attracting many visitors.

The quaint harbour, beautiful beach and coastline are excellent for inspiring artists. The village boasts several eating houses ranging from small cafes to the village pub and restaurants. There is a General Stores and Post Office, two gift shops, an art gallery and a church.



## The Course includes:-

Three days of professional art tuition with plenty of individual guidance giving the opportunity to develop your artistic skills whatever your starting point. Studio facilities overlooking the sea and coastal path.

## About the Artist:

The courses are to be led by artist Sue Lewington and will be using Watercolour. Sue has published a series of pen and watercolour sketchbooks about the Isles of Scilly and various places in Cornwall. These include St Ives, Falmouth, Fowey, and the gardens of Heligan and Eden.

## Included in the package:

Course fees cover all tutoring, unlimited use of the studio and facilities, a bottomless tea and coffee pot and home made cake. Also included are light lunches to be ordered in the morning and then delivered at lunch time so you can continue being creative. We use the local establishments of The Wave, Harbour Lights Elizabeth's pasties and Coverack Cakes. All produce excellent quality food, locally sourced.

## Itinerary.

**Fri:** Start 10am, introduction and get to know each other. This first day will be spent learning and developing watercolour techniques. There

will be a pasty lunch provided. Finish around 4.30pm. The following days will be spent developing individuals watercolour techniques with plenty of individual tuition.

**Sat:** 10am start. Stop for a lunch break at 12-1.30pm. Lunch provided by The Wave café. The day finishes around 4.30pm.

**Sun:** 10am start. Lunch break between 12-1.30pm. Lunch provided by Harbour Lights. Finish around 3.30pm. Wind down session and a chance to reflect on what has been achieved over the past few days.

## Materials

Please bring your own watercolour paints, sketch pads, pens, pencils and paintbrushes.
