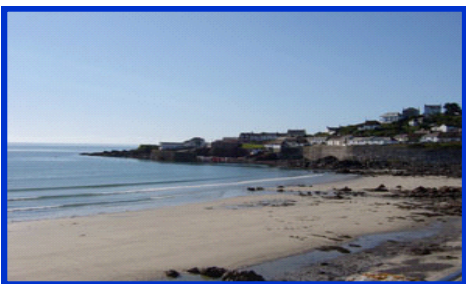

The Location:

Coverack is situated on the South West coast of Cornwall on the Lizard Peninsula. It is a small traditional fishing village and is a spectacular location attracting many visitors.

The quaint harbour, beautiful beach and coastline are excellent for inspiring artists. The village boasts several eating houses ranging from small cafes to the village pub and restaurants. There is a General Store and Post Office, two gift shops, an art gallery and a church.



The Course includes:-

A three day art course to explore making and using personal sketchbooks and journals. Professional art tuition with plenty of individual guidance what ever your starting point. Studio facilities overlooking Coverack bay.

About the Artist:

The courses are to be led by artist Sue Lewington and will be using Watercolour. Sue has published a series of pen and watercolour sketchbooks about the Isles of Scilly and various places in Cornwall. These include St Ives, Falmouth, Fowey, Heligan and Eden.

Included in the package:

Course fees cover all tutoring, unlimited use of the studio and facilities, a bottomless tea and coffee pot and home made cake. Also included are light lunches to be ordered in the morning and then delivered at lunch time so you can continue being creative.

We use the local establishments of The Wave, Harbour Lights, Elizabeth's pasties and Coverack Cakes. All produce excellent quality food, locally sourced.

Itinerary.

Fri: start 10am. Making simple stitched and folded books and an A5 hard cover watercolour sketchbook. There will be a pasty lunch provided. Finish around 4.30pm

Sat: start 10am. Finishing books. Learning and developing watercolour and drawing techniques. Stop for a lunch break at 12-1.30pm. Lunch provided by The Wave café. The day finishes around 4.30pm.

Sun: start 10am. Beginning your own personal journal. Lunch break between 12-1.30pm. Lunch provided by Harbour Lights. Finish around 3.30pm. Wind down session and a chance to reflect on what has been achieved over the past few days.



Materials:

All book making materials will be provided. A small extra charge will be made for paper (£3-£5) Please bring your own pencils, pens, watercolours, cutting mat, scalpel, ruler and scissors.

Accommodation & Food:

Accommodation is not included in our package. There are B&B's, cottages and a hotel in Coverack village. An accommodation list is available from our website :-
